CALL TO ORDER

OPEN DISCUSSION

Art Brown called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. The Committee discussed the Minutes from the April 13th Meeting.

M/S/C Becky Dean motioned to accept the Minutes from the April 13, 2022, as written. John Reed seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The Committee discussed an email that was sent to Staff by Art Brown. They determined that they want to include federal and state land as possible land that should be zoned Recreation.

IDENTIFY LOCATIONS ON ZONING MAP FOR RECREATION ZONE

The Committee reviewed maps and discussed locations that could potentially be included in the Recreation Zone. While reviewing specific parcels, the Committee encountered property that is currently being used as a Livestock Confinement Operation (LCO). They agreed not to include the property and decided they would discuss setbacks from LCOs to Recreation Zones at a later date. There was discussion on rezoning all Preservation to Recreation 3 as well as all associated Federal Land. The Committee discussed whether the Committee or individual land owners should decide if and when a parcel would be re-zoned to one of the Recreation Zones. The Committee agreed to review land, parcel by parcel, to determine if it should be included as potential Recreation areas.

The Committee asked Staff to create zoomed-in maps for the next meeting. The Committee agreed to meet on May 4, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:53 a.m.
