

**JEROME COUNTY RECREATION ZONE COMMITTEE MINUTES
JUNE 8, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

OPEN DISCUSSION

Nancy Marshall called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. and acknowledged Art Brown and Bill Baker were not in attendance. The Committee discussed the Minutes from the May 18th Meeting.

M/S/C Becky Dean motioned to accept the Minutes from the May 18, 2022, as written. John Reed seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

IDENTIFY LOCATIONS ON ZONING MAP FOR RECREATION ZONE

Staff presented the remaining maps requested by the Committee and reminded them that all federal and most state land was zoned Rec 3 on the maps as a starting point. The Committee worked through maps twelve through twenty-two. The proposed zones were marked on the maps. The paper copy for Rec Zone Map 15 was missing. The Committee agreed to propose Rec 1 for all of Map 15.

The Committee discussed the area north of Devil’s Corral and agreed that most of it is BLM property and is part of Snake River Canyons Park. The Committee debated on whether the area should be in the Rec Zone and if so, to what degree. They agreed it should be included as Rec Zone 2. The Committee reviewed the decision on maintaining consistent zoning on individual parcels that encompassed area above and below the Canyon Rim.

The Committee agreed to meet on June 29, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. to allow Staff time to update the maps with the proposed Rec Zones. The meeting will be for a final review of the maps with the proposed Rec Zones. The Committee will then move on to discuss divisions and housing density. Ms. Marshall asked the Committee members to review the ordinance and to think about how to write the division and housing density sections so that they make sense and accomplish their goals.

M/S/C Becky Dean motioned to adjourn. John Reed seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:01 p.m.
