To help you comply with the annual chemical inventory reporting required by EPCRA, the Idaho Bureau of Homeland Security encourages electronic submission via TIER II Submit software. All Forms require basic facility identification information, employee contact information (both emergency and non-emergency), and information about chemicals stored or used at the facility. Jerome County Active Shooter Tabletop Exercise with Autumn Roberts

The purpose of the Tabletop Exercise is to analyze exercise results, identify strengths to be maintained and built upon, identify potential areas for further improvement, and support development of corrective actions.

The Capabilities chosen for this exercise:

- Onsite Incident Management
- Pre-Hospital Treatment
- Medical Surge

During the Exercise; objectives were developed, major strengths identified, Primary Areas for Improvement; Update and share plans between responding agencies and create a plan for PIO coordination, to identify a Joint Information Center (JIC), Scenario and Analysis of Capabilities.

The Jerome County Active Shooter Tabletop Exercise could have been better attended but overall the city, county, school and hospital representatives were there to discuss and collaborate and assist each agency to strive and become better prepared.
