Welcome

Baldwin Camin called the meeting to order, welcomed everyone in attendance and invited members to introduce themselves.

LEPC

Minutes for Sept 2013 LEPC meeting were reviewed, changed and approved.

Old Business

Clint reports and gives us a Grant update - He says they put in an application for a radio tower and it has been submitted through Homeland Security, yet we haven't received a reply back. Clint says they have to get approval of the purchase before they go forward. Cathy Roemer says they have purchased the property and have been working closely with Clint Blackwood and Doug McFall on what has been happening. Cathy says the Airport board has passed off on it. Doug McFall gives the LEPC the information needed to move forward; It has been approved by the state and FAA (Federal Aviation Administration)

Clint says that we have been working hard on the Community Emergency Preparedness and Guidelines so we could send it out by email to each of the LEPC members for their final review. We were having some difficulty getting it in the right format that would allow such a large document to be opened. It was sent out in everyone's email just about 30 minutes before the meeting. Clint just asked for everyone to review it and let him know of any changes or add-ins you would like to see before we publish it in the Disaster Emergency Management website.

Clint says they did the South Central Community Action Partnership Even held on the 21st of September. They handed out preparedness brochures on Emergency and never put a lot of emphasis on the SIRCOMM C.A.N. but the brochures were available. This was an annual event (we are committed to participate each year) where several of the Agencies had a booth and some agencies such as the American Red Cross and Southern Baptist Convention had enlarged booths and prepared Food. Many, 70 or more in the Twin Falls area and Local Agencies participated and it was well attended.

Clint goes over the EOP Annexes – *Emergency Operation Plan* manuals were set out on the tables so we could easily review where we left off. Everyone turned to Annexes D or page 305 so everyone could get familiar with what annexes are in the manual so the LEPC group can give feedback. While Reviewing Annexes D (Point of Dispensing Operations) it was suggested by John Hathaway, we set up a 3 hour exercise at the School. Clint suggests they meet together with the Healthcare Coalition meeting and find out if they are willing to have another exercise and suggest having it in the Northern Idaho area. Baldwin, Committee Chairmen, ask John Hathaway to take charge of seeing what the possibilities would be of setting it up. All we had time for was Annex D and Annex E (Terrorism). Corrections were made on page 319; Notification Chart, (state EMS Com. Center) the BDS (Bureau of Disaster Services) and BHM (Bureau of Hazard Materials) are now one; BHS (Bureau of Homeland Security). We will resume at a later date with Annex F and G (Mass Fatalities and Volunteer Management).

New Business

All LEPC members in attendance at the October LEPC meeting were in favor to reelect Baldwin Camin as LEPC Chairman and in favor to elect Larry Goolsby to serve as Vice Chairman.
