### Old Business

Clint gives us a Grant update - He says we are operating under the 2008 HSGP grant and recently we have submitted for and received approval purchases for the Sheriffs office. A life scan, finger print and palm print reader and the software associated with that program, it has been approved and ordered and just waiting for that to come in and 3 radios that have been submitted and approved for purchase.

We are working with the City of Jerome for Critical Infrastructure Protection, working on getting their request finalized and submitted for a door access Security system and equipment. He reports that this is where we stand right now for 2008 grants and if anyone has needs within the agency we support, feel free to get ahold of him. He also says with this grant we need to act quickly because the grant will be going away in August.

### New Business

#### **Training Opportunities/Exercise**

Clint says we received information on the AWR-213 (CIKR) Critical Infrastructure/Key Resources Awareness Class in Twin Falls, July 18<sup>th</sup>. He says anyone that has anything to do with the Critical

Infrastructure/Key Resources here in Jerome County to please pick up one of the brochures. He reminds everyone that we have 19 critical areas, he read the list off and said if anyone is involved in any way or another to go to [www.idahoprepares.com](http://www.idahoprepares.com) to sign up.

Baldwin Camin introduced Autumn Roberts as our EOP workshop exercise director and then turned the time over to her. Everyone had an Emergency Operations Planning booklet and followed her as she went over each and every section; reviewing, editing and modifying it and making any changes that we see is necessary. The Exercise Objective is: Assess the adequacy of the EOP to respond to all hazard incidents in the county. Identify shortfalls in resources, limits in capabilities and conflicts in planning. She brought up and we discussed; Purpose of the EOP, Base Plan, Standard Response Guides, Emergency Support Functions, and Support Annexes. Autumn asked for each participant to please complete the feedback form and hand it back to her at the end of the EOP Exercise. Overall the feedback was very positive and Autumn did a great job in our review of the EOP Manual and presenting the issues to the LEPC group during the EOP Workshop. We look forward in reviewing the updates discussed in our workshop and supplementing these changes to better suit the needs in Jerome County in any case of a disaster.

Clint went over the resource list with everyone and asked the LEPC group to make any updates necessary for their contact information.
