**SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 261,
JEROME, GOODING AND
LINCOLN COUNTIES,

Shall the Board of Trustees of Jerome Joint School District No. 261, Jerome, Gooding, and Lincoln Counties, State of Idaho ("Board") be authorized to issue general obligation school bonds of said District, in one or more series, in a principal amount not to exceed \$26,000,000 for the purpose of constructing a new elementary school; financing the addition, remodel and/or repair of the existing Jefferson and Horizon elementary school buildings; and to repair or equip any other buildings necessary to maintain and operate the buildings of the District, such series of bonds to become due in such installments as may be fixed by the Board, for a term not to exceed twenty years, all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board on February 25, 2020?

The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bond issue is 2.42% per annum. The total amount estimated to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$26,668,966 consisting of \$26,000,000 in principal and \$7,215,800 of interest, totaling \$33,215,800, less \$6,546,834 in estimated bond levy equalization payments. The term of the bonds will not exceed 20 years. The total existing bonded indebtedness of the District, including interest accrued, is \$36,411,475.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed bond levy is a tax of \$88 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The District's existing levies for prior bonds and other levy items are expected to decrease by \$88 per \$100,000 resulting in no net change in the District's total property tax rate if the proposed bonds are approved.
